FROM THE DESK OF MR. KAPPERMAN

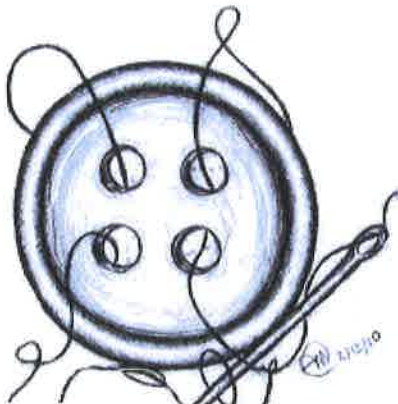
Dear Immaculate Conception School Families:

Clayton Bailey (Veteran)- Served in the New York State Guard from 1943-1945 then drafted in the Army Air Force from 1945 through 1946. He was assigned to the 8th Airforce as a ball turret gunner on a B24 Bomber. After returning to civilian life he joined the American Legion Post 362 and eventually became a member of the Legion's Drum and Bugle Core. Clayton has been a fifty year member and past president & secretary of the Kiwanis Club of EA, a volunteer driver for Rural Transit & the American Cancer Society & a docent at the Historic Roycroft Campus.

Roger LeBlanc (Citizen)- has volunteered with the East Aurora Volunteer Fire Department over the past 28 years. After joining the EAFD in 1990, Roger was elected to 2nd Lt, 1st Lt, Captain, Assistant Chief, and Chief, which he held from 2001-2015. He is currently the EAFD President and Safety Officer. Roger was also elected to the Erie County Fire Advisory Board from 2009 -2014. He is a member of the Buffalo Deaf Club, completed level 6 at Deaf Access Services in American Sign Language and teaches basic ASL to 1st responders. As a volunteer, Roger has been making house calls and assisting neighbors in their time of need beside all of the other dedicated individuals that give up their time for others.

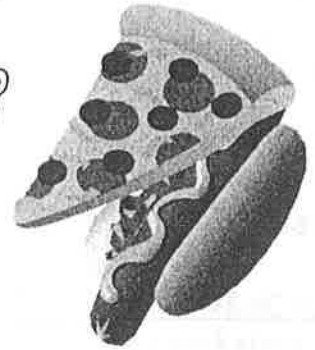
